Call to Worship - Responsive Reading from 1 John

Leader: This is the message you have heard from the beginning:
We should love one another.

People: See how very much our Father loves us, for he calls us his children.

Leader: We know what real love is because Jesus gave up his life for us.

People: So we also ought to give up our lives for our brothers and sisters.

Leader: Let's not merely say that we love each other; let us show the truth by our actions.

People: Let us continue to love one another, for love comes from God. Anyone who loves is a child of God and knows God.

Leader: God showed how much he loved us by sending his one and only Son into the world so that we might have eternal life through him.

People: This is real love—not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins.

Leader: Since God loved us that much, we surely ought to love each other.

People: If we love each other, God lives in us, and his love is brought to full expression in us.

Leader: God is love, and all who live in love live in God, and God lives in them.

People: As we live in God, our love grows more perfect.

Leader: Love has no fear, because perfect love expels all fear.

All: We love each other because he loved us first.

1 Corinthians 13:1-13

¹ If I speak in the tongues of mortals and of angels, but do not have love, I am a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal. ² And if I have prophetic powers, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but

do not have love, I am nothing. ³ If I give away all my possessions, and if I hand over my body so that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing. ⁴ Love is patient; love is kind; love is not envious or boastful or arrogant ⁵ or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; ⁶ it does not rejoice in wrongdoing, but rejoices in the truth. ⁷ It bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. ⁸ Love never ends. But as for prophecies, they will come to an end; as for tongues, they will cease; as for knowledge, it will come to an end. ⁹ For we know only in part, and we prophesy only in part; ¹⁰ but when the complete comes, the partial will come to an end. ¹¹ When I was a child, I spoke like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child; when I became an adult, I put an end to childish ways. ¹² For now we see in a mirror, dimly, but then we will see face to face. Now I know only in part; then I will know fully, even as I have been fully known. ¹³ And now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; and the greatest of these is love.
